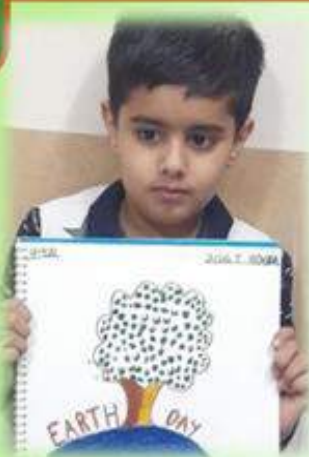

*"Freedom is priceless, We must value it."*

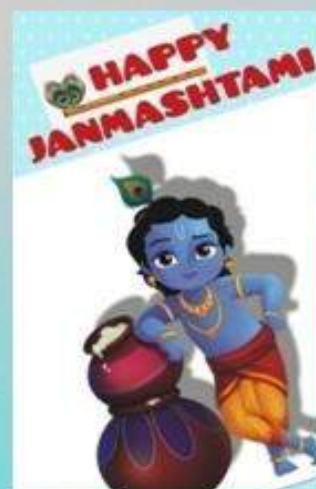

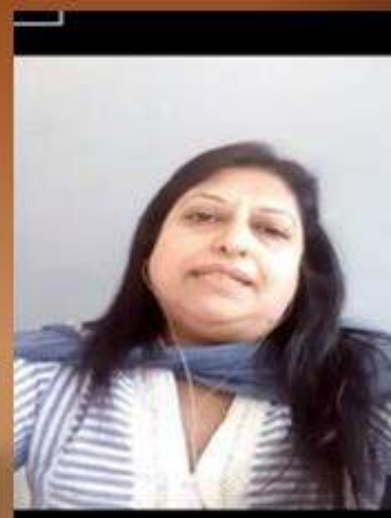
## BASANT PANCHAMI AND YELLOW COLOUR DAY CELEBRATION
