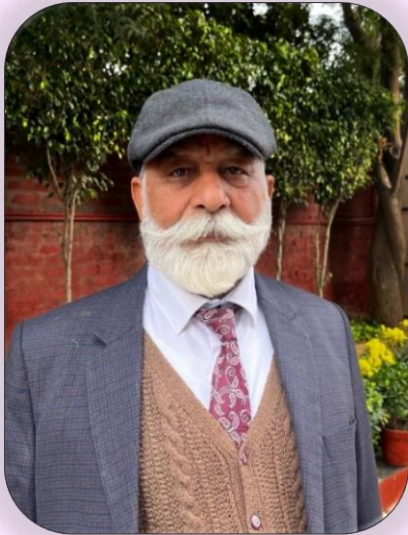

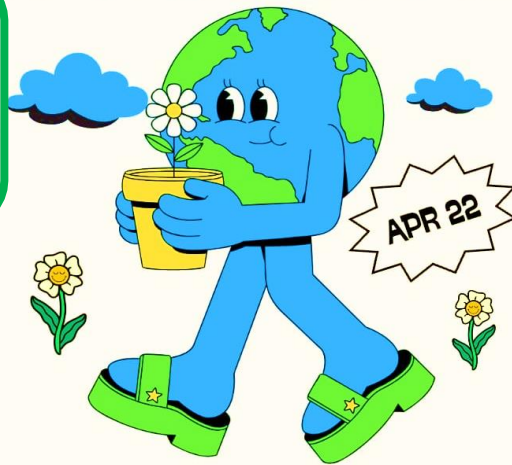
A JOYFUL EXPLORATION

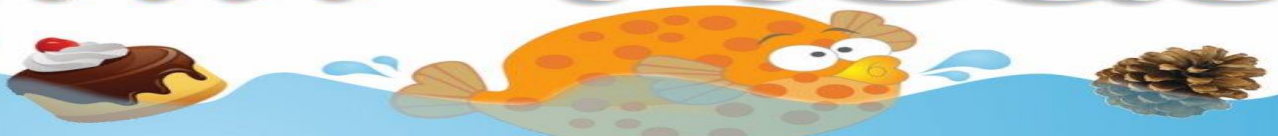
SINK OR FLOAT

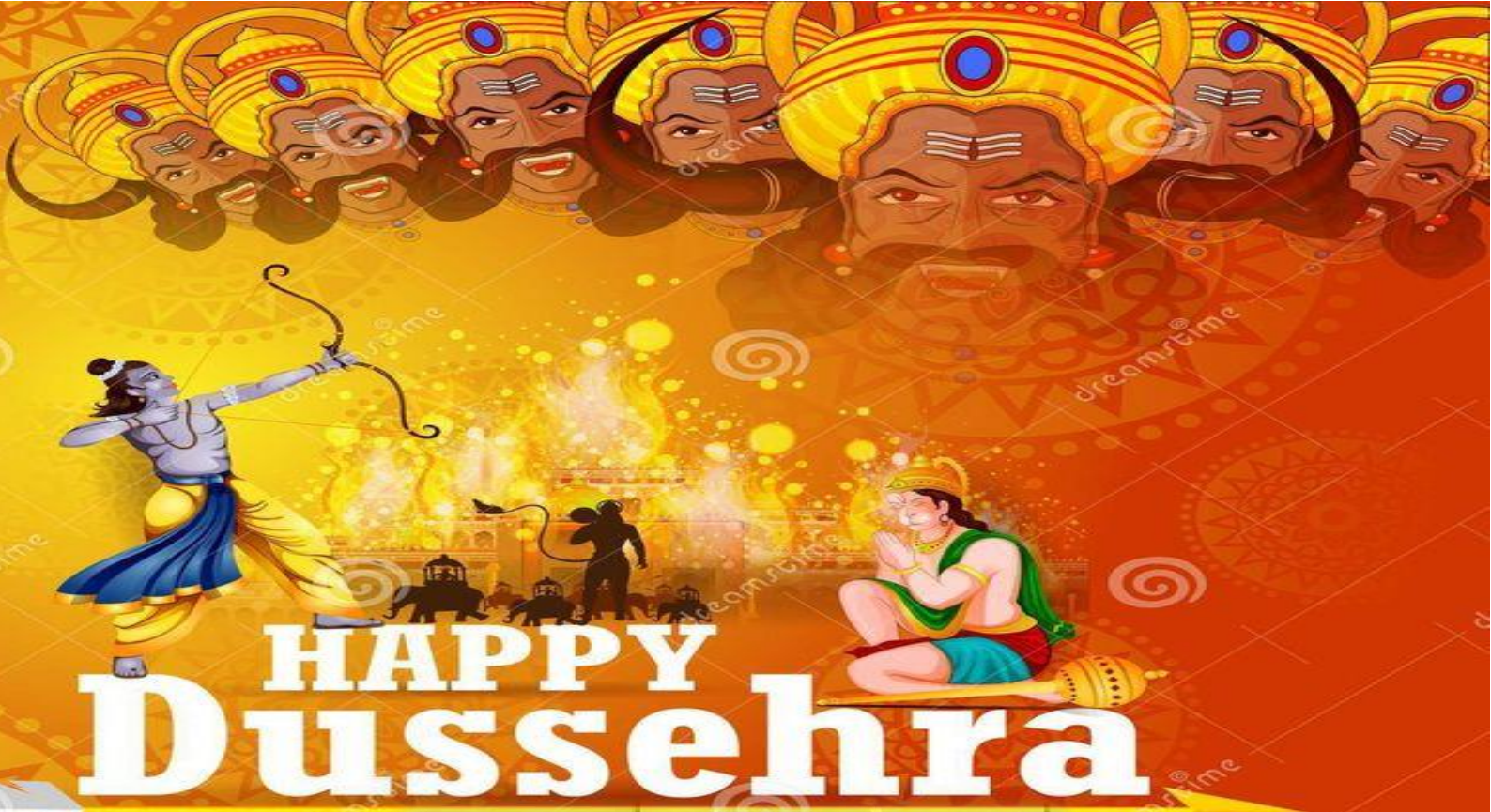


NEIGHBOURHOOD

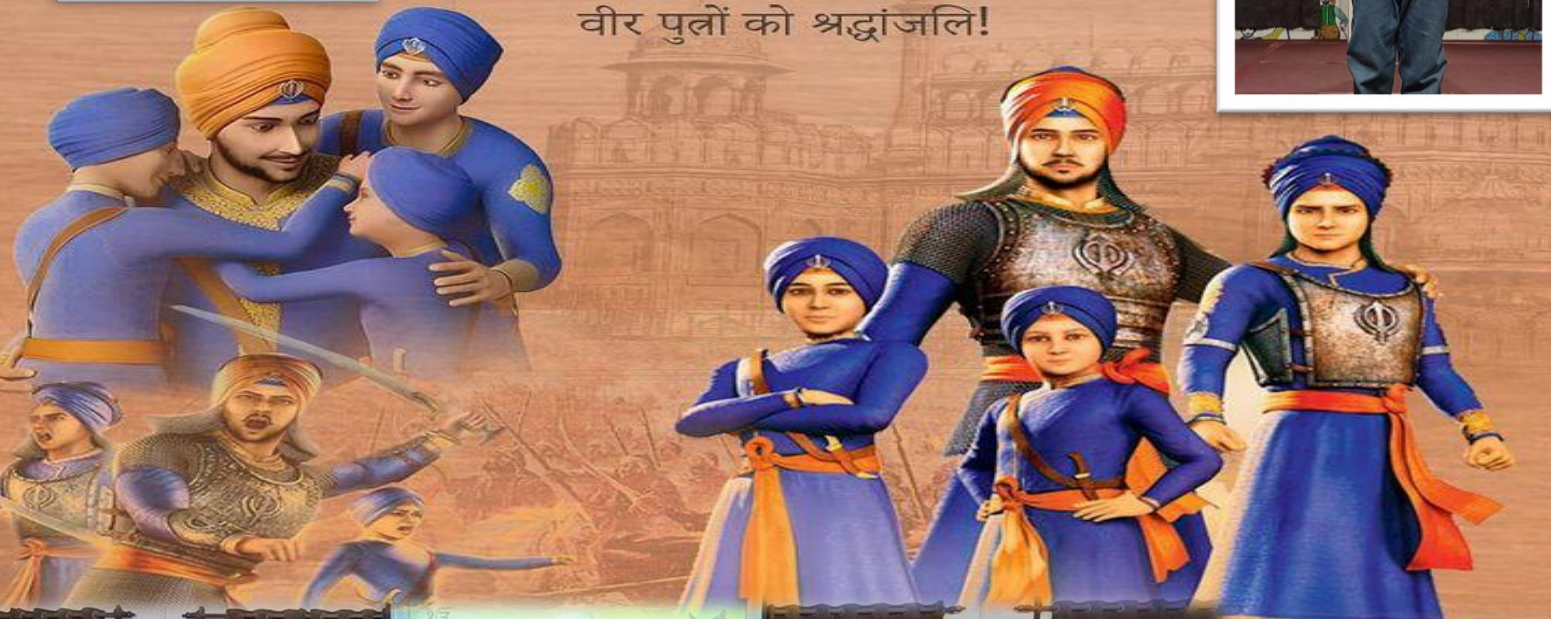

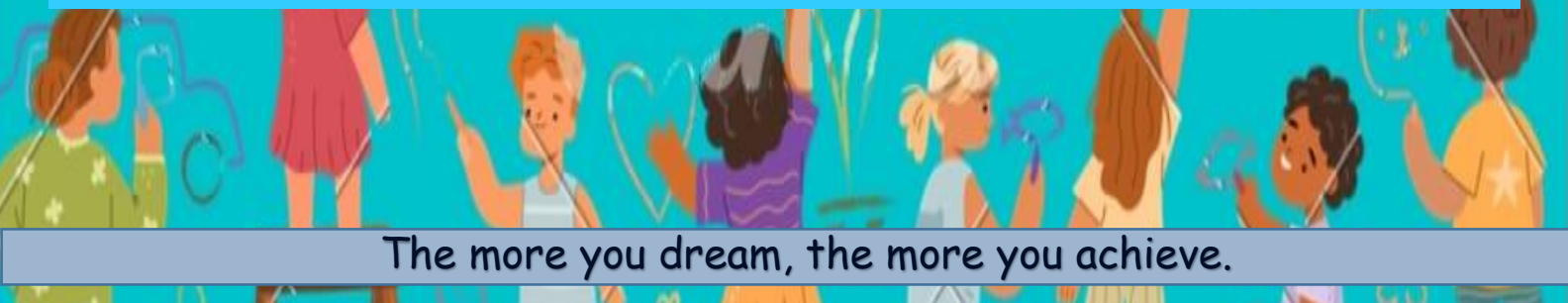
